

## How to shop on ChapelMusic.com:

Please note: Because of copyright and tax laws, we are currently able to make sales to persons living in the United States.

### 1. Add music to your shopping cart:

1. Browse by Genres / Artist or use search to find individual tracks or albums you want to purchase
2. Click on the "Add to cart"

### 2. Purchase the music

1. Click on the checkout button
2. Create a new account or login on ChapelMusic.com

#### **New Account**

To create a new account, you will be asked to

- provide your name, email address, billing address
- optionally ask to receive email updates
- create a password for future visits (minimum of 5 characters)

#### **Login**

To login, use your email address and password

You will be asked to confirm your billing address. This should match the credit card you will use to pay for your purchases.

Finally, you will be asked to confirm your order.

### 3. Purchase through PayPal

Login to PayPal

You will be asked to confirm the charge

Print a receipt if you want

Your browser should automatically return to ChapelMusic.com (If it doesn't you can click "Return to Pacific Press Publishing Association

### **3. Download your music to your computer**

Click on each of the song tracks to Save the files to location on your machine

Be sure to Save and not Open the files

Be sure to note the location where the music is being saved to.

On PCs, we recommend saving your files in the "My Music" folder (found in "My Documents")

### **4. Play the music**

You can import each track into your default music player by double clicking on the track.

You can also open your favorite music player and import several tracks at once.
